## At the conclusion of the program, participants should be able to:

- Apply the knowledge of the current State Newborn Screening Program to their practice
- Identify school mental health and behavioral issues and manage them
- Apply current guidelines for management of common pediatric infections in their practice
- Employ newer techniques in the management of wounds
- Describe the current State Trauma System

## PALS Recertification Course (Optional)

An optional Pediatric Advanced Life Support Recertification course will be held on Friday, September 17, 2010; 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM. This course is open to meeting registrants who currently hold a PALS Provider certification that is not more than 30 days past due. The Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) course is designed to aid the pediatric healthcare provider in developing the knowledge and skills necessary to efficiently evaluate and effectively manage seriously ill infants and children. All participants receive a PALS Provider Manual, PALS Student Guide and an American Heart Association BLS for Healthcare Providers Online Key Code as part of their pre-course packet. All participants are required to complete the BLS online module and the PALS Pre-Course exam prior to class attendance. The course fee is **\$150.00**, which includes lunch, refreshment breaks, the PALS Provider Manual, PALS Student Guide and access to the AHA BLS Healthcare Provider online site.
